

Description:

Requirements:

Students applying for the Ambassador program must:

- Be a rising Sophomore, Junior or Senior at an accredited Metro-Atlanta college or university
- Have at least two full semesters left
- Be able to serve as an Ambassador for two (2) consecutive semesters
- Hold at least a 2.90 GPA on a 4.0 scale, as confirmed by school
- Be able to attend the end-of-summer orientation

(Communication, Business or Entertainment Business majors are preferred, but not necessary.)

To Apply:

Fill out our online application (www.zoomatl.com/cap/application). Before you begin, make sure you have an 'angle' – as part of the program, we may ask you to submit a piece for publication or to "take over" our social media and we want to make sure you're ready for whatever comes your way!

Once your application has been reviewed, you will be notified via email if you have advanced to the second round of interviews. Those who have advanced will receive instructions on setting up a phone interview with our Ambassador Lead.

Once all interviews have been completed, potential Ambassadors will be notified of their acceptance decision no later than June 14, 2016. If you have been accepted, you will receive necessary paperwork, information on the end-of-summer orientation and further details on what needs to be completed before your campus's Fall term starts.
